Applications are invited for NOC for those faculty members from Government and Aided Engineering Colleges under this Department who wish to apply for admission to Ph.D / Pre-Ph.D (Advance Admission to Ph.D) under Quality Improvement Programme for the year 2025-26.

Full time regular / permanent teachers (such as Assistant Professors, Associate Professors, Professors) of AICTE approved Degree Level Engineering Institutions having two years teaching experience with continuous service as on 01.07.2025 and do not exceed the age limit of 45 years (as on 01.07.2025) are eligible to apply for admission to Advance Admission to Ph.D.

The applicants are directed to submit their application through the online facility provided in the website "**www.admissions.dtekerala.gov.in/tpms**" and forward the hard copy with supporting documents to this Office through proper channel so as to receive in this Office on or before 15.03.2025.

The Principals concerned are requested to receive the applications and forward the same after observing the guidelines issued vide Government Orders cited above and forward to Directorate of Technical Education within the stipulated time. The principals of aided institutions shall forward the applications through the concerned Joint Directors of RDTE.

The Joint Directors of the respective Regional Directorates should verify the details of faculty members(aided) received from the Principals and furnish the same to this Office within the stipulated time with detailed report regarding each candidate. NOC will be issued by this Office to the eligible candidates through the Principals concerned after scrutinizing the details received from the respective Jonit Directors. Those who got NOC from this Office alone are eligible for applying to QIP Centre for admission. The Principal concerned should forward the applications of eligible teachers directly to the respective QIP Centre after getting NOC from this Office. NOC will be issued only to those candidates who have applied the QIP Centres as IITs, NITs and State Universities with NIRF ranking below 50.
